# Overview:

Where: North Campus Field

When: Games start at 9 am

- If your team is playing first round, check in at 8:15 am
- Check in 30 minutes before your playing time!
- We cannot change your start time!
- **Bring your UConn ID**

# Check in:

- No Day of Substitutions!
- You will have until **11:59 pm on Friday** to make changes to your roster. We encourage teams of 6 to add subs onto roster.
- ALL team members must be together to start check in
- Student ID's will be collected
- If your team checks in without a player but still meet the roster requirements (6 players with at least 2 male and female participants) than the team can still play but the missing player/s cannot
- Will be given an OOzeball wristband- Must be worn at all times during the event

# Teams

- 6 - 8 Players
- 6 players on the court at a time
- 2 female and 2 male players on the court at all times
- If you do not meet these requirements your team will not be allowed to play
- Players can only compete on **ONE** team

# Substitutions

- Substitutions for players **CANNOT** be made on the day of OOzeball
- Additions and substitutions to your roster can be made on IM Leagues until **11:59 pm on Friday, April 26th!**
  - Remember Captain must accept roster by this deadline

# Game Rules:

- 12 minute games or to 25 points, whichever comes first
- Rally scoring
- In the event of a tie, next point wins
- Running time - The clock does not stop!
- Serving team will be decided by Rock, Paper, Scissors

# Game Rules

- A ball touching the boundary line is in
- Your team can touch the ball 3 times before it must go over the net
- **NO SPIKING OR BLOCKING!**
- All games are self refereed
- If a dispute arises redo the point

# Game Rules

- Your team will forfeit, if all players are not at the court at the start time of the game
- A substitute may replace a player when the ball is dead. You may only replace that player for the rest of the game.



# Details of Tournament

- Single Elimination
- First Round Games occur from 9am – around 3pm.
- During first round games if you win, you will play your next game within a couple minutes of conclusion
- If you win this part of bracket (~5 games) you will return to the championship bracket at around 3:30pm
- If you cannot make later times, you will be forfeited

# What to wear

- Gym shorts or long pants are required
- We encourage team themes/uniforms
- Dress for the weather. We play RAIN OR SHINE!
- **Tennis shoes/sneakers** must be worn at all times - NO sandals! NO bare feet!

# Accidents

- Should any accidents occur during the game, the nature of which hinders the normal progress of the game or endangers the safety of the team members, all activity ceases until the injured player is off the court
- If the player is unable to continue, the alternates should substitute

# Disqualifications

- DO NOT come under the influence of or with any drugs/alcohol
- No fighting/disorderly conduct
- Disqualifications are decided at the discretion of the OOzeball Coordinator and Court Monitors
- Disqualified teams do not receive a refund

# Completion of Play

- Players MUST wash themselves off at designated hosing station
- You will not be given your ID back or a T-shirt until you are considered clean
- You will be subject to UConn policy if you enter a campus building without cleaning off

# Spectators

- Spectators are allowed onto the site for free
- Spectators will be given a spectator wristband
- Spectators are not allowed into the playing area and mud

# Have you played before? The major changes:

- Additions, Substitutions and Rosters can be made until 11:59 pm this Friday.
  - If you are not on a team by this time YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PLAY
- No on site substitutions
- No need to sign paper waivers at check in, all done through IM Leagues
  - If you are not on IM Leagues you cannot play since we need a waiver
